ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS'  
MOTION TO AMEND OR  
SUPPLEMENT

This matter having come before the Court on Respondents' Motion to Dismiss, and the Court having read the pleadings on the motion, heard the argument of counsel, and being in all matters duly advised, hereby,

ORDERS that Plaintiffs' request to be permitted to submit additional facts that Plaintiffs allege further support their arguments that the court has jurisdiction and Plaintiffs have standing is hereby granted. If Plaintiffs have further facts to support their opposition to the Motion to Dismiss those must be presented in either an amended verified complaint or in a sworn declaration. The Court will not consider facts or make inferences from information supplied solely in briefing or oral argument. It is further,

ORDERED that if Plaintiffs still want to amend their pleadings or supply additional declarations/affidavits, they shall do so by no later than 5:00 p.m., December 7, 2018. Any Motion to Amend shall be noted before this Judicial Officer. It is further,

ORDERED that if Plaintiffs do not supplement or amend by December 7, 2018, this Court shall rule on the Motion to Dismiss without further briefing or oral argument on the Motion. It is further,


ORDERED that if Plaintiffs supplement or amend their pleadings, both parties will notify the court and the other side in writing by 5:00 p.m. December 14, 2018 whether or not they wish to do supplemental briefing and oral argument. Notice to the court may be sent by email to the law clerk provided it is in a letter attachment to the email that can be filed in the court file. It is further,

ORDERED that if neither side requests further briefing and oral argument, the Court will rule on the Motion without further oral argument. It is further,

ORDERED that if either side requests further argument or briefing the moving party, Defendants, shall file any supplemental brief by December 28 2018. The Plaintiffs shall respond by January 4, 2019 and Respondent shall file any reply by January 8, 2019. It is further,

ORDERED that if further briefing is done, further oral argument will occur at a hearing hereby set for January 18, 2019 at 1:30 pm.
