Motion to Dismiss for lack of Personal Jurisdiction by BUL USA


Upon the matters presented to the Court at the hearing, it is hereby

ADJUDGED, ORDERED, and DECREED as follows:


① This matter requires an evidentiary hearing to the challenge of personal jurisdiction. Within 14 days, Plaintiff is to submit to Judge Shannon limited proposed discovery related to the following: (1) the corporate formalities maintained between BUL USA & Okori; (2) why the trade name BOP Builders was registered to BUL USA; and (3) why BUL USA was not a party to the agreement between Okori & Solvo Technologies

② After the Court rules on whether and to what extent discovery is permitted, it will set an evidentiary hearing on the issue of personal jurisdiction.
